

Human trafficking is a complex and costly assault on the lives of those affected.

Survivors of trafficking struggle to overcome legal impediments that stand in the way of recovery and justice. With diverse legal needs, high levels of vulnerability and difficulty accessing critical resources, these populations are in a uniquely challenging position. ALIGHT works to facilitate connections and collaboration between service providers, advocates and the legal community through the use of pioneering mobile technology to deliver justice and support for human trafficking survivors.

About the Pilot

For the first time, we have the opportunity to use real-time, mobile technology that can match diverse legal needs of survivors posted by service providers and advocates to relevant and available legal expertise. There will be three phases:

- **PREP:** recruit and review participants, distribute training materials including User Guide and Guidelines, set-up and orientation
- **PILOT:** field use of the 4Bells app for 3 months by participants, with monitoring and support
- POST: collect and analyze feedback, and determine strategic next steps for extending technology use


What It Offers
