ALIGHT is a 501(c)(3) that **removes the legal barriers preventing human trafficking survivors from rebuilding their lives**, by partnering with qualified volunteer attorneys for pro bono advocacy, counsel and representation on civil, criminal and family law matters. Backed by MIT Solve award-winning technology, ALIGHT makes finding impactful, flexible and practice-aligned pro bono opportunities as easy as opening an app on your phone!

- As co-founder of the National Survivor Law Collective, ALIGHT works alongside peer legal organizations nationally to build survivor-centered legal practice.
- Our network spans solo practitioners to national firms, including Holland & Knight and Brownstein.
- ALIGHT launched the ABA Human Trafficking Awareness Series in 2025 and offers Trauma-Informed Lawyering training to prepare attorneys for work with survivors.

WHY NATIONWIDE?

After launching in Colorado in 2015, we saw a clear need for a national network of pro bono attorneys. Human trafficking does not respect state lines, and neither do the legal challenges survivors face once they escape. Custody disputes, criminal records and coerced debt often follow survivors across jurisdictions, while qualified legal support for this population remains scarce across much of the country, a gap confirmed by the [Legal Deserts Report, 2021](#). In response, ALIGHT expanded our services to two of the highest-need regions. We now welcome attorneys from Colorado, Utah and the 5-county Greater Los Angeles Area to join our network and help meet this urgent need.

OUR IMPACT

- connected **440+** survivors with attorneys across **1,000+** legal matters;
- delivered **\$3.8M+** in pro bono legal services
- **1 of only 16** sex trafficking survivor-focused legal programs in the US ([Legal Deserts Report, 2021](#)).

BENEFITS OF JOINING

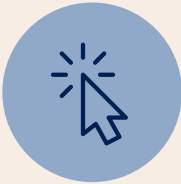
Joining ALIGHT's network is a flexible, low-friction way to do meaningful pro bono work — without the overhead of finding and vetting opportunities yourself.
